YARMOUTH, Mass. – *The Wall That Heals*, a three-quarter scale replica of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial along with a mobile Education Center, is coming to Yarmouth, Mass. ON SEPTEMBER 17TH – 20TH 2026 to Parkers River Landing, 669 Route 28, Yarmouth, Mass. and will be open 24 hours a day and free to the public. **We are honored to be the ONLY stop in Massachusetts for 2026.**

The Wall That Heals honors the more than three million Americans who served in the U.S. Armed forces in the Vietnam War, and it bears the names of the 58,281 men and women who made the ultimate sacrifice in Vietnam.
